From our humble beginnings making just 20 layettes the first time out, we have expanded exponentially thanks to wonderful members and friends who support the vision of Christ Child Society and our founder, MVM. "Nothing is ever too much to do for a child." Today we have distributed over 6,500 layettes to moms and babies in need. We have expanded our other service projects to provide hygiene items (and warm hats & gloves) to elementary students in our low income schools. We support the Families In Transition office to provide needed hygiene items to homeless teens along with blankets, socks, and other necessities. We have beautiful handmade bereavement sets provided to grieving families that lose their baby. We keep an open and giving heart year-round looking for new ways we can "see the Christ Child in every child."
